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The *Torah* of *Yah Adonai* is perfect, restoring the inner man. The instruction of Yah Adonai is sure, making wise the thoughtless. The precepts of Yah Adonai are right, rejoicing the heart. The *mitzvot* of *Yah Adonai* is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of Yah Adonai is clean, enduring forever. The rulings of Yah Adonai are true, they are righteous altogether,

more desirable than gold, than much fine gold, also sweeter than honey or drippings from the honeycomb. How blessed are those who reject the advice of the wicked, don't stand on the way of sinners or sit where scoffers sit! Their delight is in the Torah of Yah Adonai; and on His Torah they meditate day and night. They are like trees planted by streams

bearing their fruit in season, their leaves never wither, everything they do succeeds. Here the days are coming, says Yah Adonai, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers on the day I took them by their hand and brought them out of the land of Egypt; because they,

for their part violated my covenant, even though I, for my part, was a husband to them, says Adonai. "For this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days," says Yah Adonai: "I will put my Torah within them and write it on their hearts; I will be their *Elohim*, and they will be my people. No longer will any of them teach his fellow community member or his brother, 'Know Yah Adonai, for all will know Me,

from the least of them to the greatest; because I will forgive their wickedness and remember their sins no more. "I will betroth you to Me forever; yes, I will betroth you to Me in righteousness, in justice, in grace and in compassion; I will betroth you to Me in faithfulness, and you will know Yah Adonai."

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit inside you; I will take the stony heart out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put my Spirit inside you and cause you to live by my laws, respect my rulings and obey them. You will live in the land I gave to your ancestors. You will be my people, and I will be your *Elohim*.

For this mitzvah which I am giving you today is not too hard for you it is not beyond your reach It isn't in the sky, so that you need to ask, Who will go up into the sky for us, bring it to us and make us hear it, so that we can obey it? Likewise, it isn't beyond the sea, so that you need to ask, Who will cross the sea for us, bring it to us and make us hear it, so that we can obey it?

On the contrary, the Word is very close to you - in your mouth, even in your heart; therefore, you can do it! "Look! I am presenting you today with, on the one hand, life and good; and on the other, death and evil - in that I am ordering you today to love Yah Adonai your Elohim.

to follow His Ways, and to obey His Mitzvot, regulations and rulings; for if you do, you will live and increase your numbers; and Yah Adonai your Elohim will bless you in the land you are entering in order to take possession of it. "Don't think that I have come to abolish the Torah or the Prophets. I have come not to abolish but to complete."

Yes indeed! I tell you that until heaven & earth pass away, not so much as a yud or a stroke will pass from the Torah – not until everything that must happen has happened. So whoever disobeys the least of these *mitzvot* & teaches others to do so will be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven. But whoever obeys them & teaches so will be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven

Does it follow that we abolish *Torah* by this trusting? Heaven forbid! On the contrary, we confirm *Torah*.

Therefore, what are we to say? That the *Torah* is sinful? Heaven forbid! Rather, the function of the *Torah* was that without it, I would not have known what sin is.

So the *Torah* is holy; that is, the *mitzvot* is holy, just and good.

So that the just requirement of the *Torah* might be fulfilled in us who do not run our lives according to what our old nature wants but according to what the Spirit wants.

Many Gentiles will go and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of Yah Adonai to the house of the *Elohim* of Ya'akov! He will teach us about His Ways, and we will walk in His paths. For out of Zion will go forth *Torah*, the Word of *Yah* Adonai our Elohim from Yerushalayim.

He will judge between many peoples and arbitrate for many nations far away. Then they will hammer their swords into plowblades and their spears into pruning-knives; nations will not raise swords at each other, and they will no longer learn war. For the Word of Yah Adonai is true, and all His work is trustworthy.

By the Word of *Yah Adonai* the heavens were made, and their whole host by a breath from His mouth.

I treasure Your Word in my heart, so that I won't sin against You. Your Word is a lamp for my foot and light on my path. Let my tongue sing of Your promise, because all Your *mitzvot* are righteous.

I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy Name for thy loving kindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy Word above all thy Name. See, the Word of Yah Adonai is alive! It is at work and is sharper than any two-edged sword it cuts right through to where soul meets spirit and joints meet marrow, and it is quick to judge the inner reflections and attitudes of the heart.

When I found Your Words, I devoured them; Your Words made me glad, they gave me joy; because, Yah Adonai –Tzva'ot, You had me bear Your Name. And recalling too how from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which can give you the wisdom that leads to deliverance through trusting in Yeshua the Messiah.

All Scripture is God-breathed and is valuable for teaching the truth, convicting of sin, correcting faults and training in right living; thus anyone who belongs to our *Elohim* may be fully equipped for every good work. I made Your Name known to the people You gave me out of the world.

They were Yours, You gave them to me, and they have kept Your Word. I have given them Your Word, and the world hated them, because they do not belong to the world just as I myself do not belong to the world. Set them apart for holiness by means of the truth – Your Word is truth.
